## Cape Canaveral Lighthouse & Museum Visit Guidelines and Logistics

**On-Site Behavior:** (please review with students before your visit to the lighthouse)

- Students will be divided into small groups based on the number in the tour. Students must stay with their assigned group at all times during the tour.
- Students must be accompanied by a chaperone at all times.
- Students must stay on the marked walkway between the parking lot and the museum/lighthouse.
- Students must respect signs which indicate private areas of the lighthouse and museum, closed doors and yellow chains which indicate no admission.
- No running is allowed anywhere on the site or in any buildings.
- No food, candy, beverages or gum are allowed in the lighthouse or museum.
- Students should use their inside voices and show respect to other visitors.
- Students should use their listening skills and raise their hands when asking or answering questions.
- Children must be 48 inches tall to climb the lighthouse stairs.
- Climbers may not wear flip flops, slide sandals or high heeled shoes.
- Running, jumping and stomping on the lighthouse stairs and landings is forbidden.
- Do not pass other climbers on the stairs or landings.

**Location:** The Cape Canaveral Lighthouse is located inside a secure Air Force Station, therefore tour groups cannot enter without a badged escort. You will be met by your assigned escort at the Sands Space History Center parking lot.

**Directions:** From the south and east travel north on AIA and take Exit 54A ("A" Terminal Exit) on the right onto SR401. You will see signs directing you to the Sands History Center. You will pass through two traffic lights. Just beyond the Cape Pass & Identification Building, turn right onto

Poseidon Avenue. Immediately turn left into the History Center parking lot.

From the north and west travel east on State Road 528 (Beachline/Bennett Cswy.). Take Exit 54A ("A" Terminal Exit) on the right onto SR401. You will see signs directing you to the Sands History Center. From this point, continue directions given above.

From the parking lot you will be directed by your assigned escort through the CCAFS gate and to the lighthouse.

## **Special Notes to teachers:**

If your tour includes a tour of the Air Force Space and Missile Museum and/or the Sands Space History Center you will receive information when you register for your tour of the Cape Canaveral Lighthouse. You will also be given information about possible locations for the students to eat lunches, which are brought with them on the tour.

Students who cannot be photographed should wear a visible lanyard, sticker or other indicator.

The Lighthouse is not accessible to visitors with disabilities.

The Museum and restrooms are accessible.
